Syllabus and General Instructions for of Assistant-A Examination:

1. Scheme of Examination:

a) The details of the Written Examination are mentioned below:

- b) Question paper will be of Objective Type Multiple Choice only. The questions will be set both in English & Hindi.
- d) The schedule of examination indicated in the Notice is tentative. Exact date of examination will be informed to candidates only by call letters sent through email and notice published on the website of the Institute.
- e) There shall be no provision for re-evaluation/ re-checking of scores at any stage/ paper(s) of the Examination. No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.

2. Indicative Syllabus for Written Test:

a) General Intelligence & Reasoning:

It would include questions of both verbal and non-verbal type. This component may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, spatial orientation, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non-verbal series, coding and decoding, statement conclusion, syllogistic reasoning etc. The topics are, Semantic Analogy, Symbolic/Number Analogy, Figural Analogy, Semantic Classification, Symbolic/Number Classification, Figural Classification, Semantic Series, Number Series, Figural Series, Problem Solving, Word Building, Coding & de-coding, Numerical Operations, symbolic Operations, Trends, Space Orientation, Space Visualization, Venn Diagrams, Drawing inferences, Punched hole/ pattern- folding& un-folding, Figural Pattern-folding and completion, Indexing, Address matching, Date & city matching, Classification of centre codes/roll numbers, Small & Capital letters/numbers coding, 21 decoding and classification, Embedded Figures, Critical thinking, Emotional Intelligence, Social Intelligence.

b) General Awareness:

Questions in this component will be aimed at testing the candidates' general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observations and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Policy & Scientific Research.



c) Quantitative Aptitude:

The questions will be designed to test the ability of appropriate use of numbers and number sense of the candidate. The scope of the test will be computation of whole numbers, decimals, fractions and relationships between numbers, Percentage, Ratio & Proportion, Square roots, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, Partnership Business, Mixture and Alligation, Time and distance, Time & Work, Basic algebraic identities of School Algebra & Elementary surds, Graphs of Linear Equations, Triangle and its various kinds of centres, Congruence and similarity of triangles, Circle and its chords, tangents, angles subtended by chords of a circle, common tangents to two or more circles, Triangle, Quadrilaterals, Regular Polygons, Circle, Right Prism, Right Circular Cone, Right Circular Cylinder, Sphere, Hemispheres, Rectangular Parallelepiped, Regular Right Pyramid with triangular or square base, Trigonometric ratio, Degree and Radian Measures, Standard Identities, Complementary angles, Heights and Distances, Histogram, Frequency polygon, Bar diagram & Pie chart.

3. Skill Test(Typing):

- (i) After the written Examination, the candidates will have to appear in the Skill Test for English or Hindi. The candidates will be given one dictation for 10 minutes in English typing speed on computer with 8000 key depression per hour or Hindi with typing speed of 6000 key depressions.
- (ii) Candidates who opt to take typing skill test in Hindi will be required to learn English typing and vice versa after their appointment, failing which their probation will not be cleared by the Institute.
- (ii) The Skill Test will be held at the Institute Office at Pune or at any other Centre(s) as may be decided by the Institute.

4. Admission to the Examination:

- a) All candidates who have applied in response to this Institute's advertisement and whose applications are found to be in order and are provisionally shortlisted by the Institute as per the terms and conditions of the advertisement, will be notified by placing the list on the website of the Institute. They will be issued Admission call letter for appearing in the Examination and Skill/Typing test.
- b) Admission call letter for the written test will be issued online by email to the shortlisted candidates as per the email ID mentioned in their application.
- c) Candidates must confirm their attendance by filling details on google form which will be sent by email. The form includes Registration-ID, registered Email-ID and Mobile Number along with name, date of birth and name of the examination.
- d) In addition to the admission call letter, it is mandatory to carry at least two passport size recent colour photographs, Original valid Photo-ID proof having the Date of Birth as printed on the Admission Certificate, such as:
 - (i) Aadhaar Card/ Printout of E-Aadhaar,
 - (ii) Voter's ID Card, (iii) Driving License,
 - (iv) PAN Card,
 - (v) Passport,
 - (vi) School/ College ID Card,
 - (vii) Employer ID Card (Govt./PSU/Private), etc
 - (viii) Ex-serviceman Discharge Book issued by Ministry of Defence, (ix) Any other photo bearing ID Card issued by the Central/State Government.



- (e) If Photo Identity Card does not have the date of birth printed on it then the candidate must carry an additional original document (e.g. Matriculation Certificate, Marks Sheet issued only by CBSE/ICSE/State Boards; Birth Certificate, Category Certificate etc.) as proof of their date of birth. In case of mismatch in the date of birth mentioned in the Admission call letter and photo ID/ Certificate brought in support of date of birth, the candidate will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- f) Any other document mentioned in the Admission call letter will be carried by the candidates while appearing in the Examination.

5. Document Verification:

The candidates are required to appear for Document Verification along with the photocopies and original documents as and when asked by the concerned authority(ies).

- (i) Candidates will have to submit copies of various documents as given below at the time of Document Verification by the User Organizations/Offices:
- i. Matriculation/Secondary Certificate.
 - ii. Educational Qualification Certificate.
 - iii. Order/letter in respect of equivalent Educational Qualifications indicating the Authority (number and date) under which it has been so treated, in respect of equivalent clause in Esser Educational Qualifications, if a candidate is claiming a particular qualification as equivalent qualification as per the requirement of the Notice of examination.
 - iv. Caste/ Category Certificate, if belongs to reserved categories.
 - v. Persons with Disabilities Certificate in the required format, if applicable.
 - vi. For Ex-Servicemen (ESM):
Serving Defence Personnel Certificates as per Annexure-VI, if applicable.
Undertaking as per Annexure-VII.
Discharge Certificate, if discharged from the Armed Forces.
 - vii. Relevant Certificate if seeking any age relaxation.
 - viii. Certificate as per Annexure-V by the Central Government Civilian Employees.
 - ix. No Objection Certificate, in case already employed in Government/ Government undertakings.

6. Mode of Selection:

- a) Based on the marks scored in the written Examination and those who qualify in typing skill, a merit list will be drawn as per Category wise vacancies respectively.
- b) Skill Test is mandatory but qualifying in nature. The Institute will fix the qualifying standards in the Skill Test for each category separately. The candidates who qualify the Skill Test will only be considered for final selection on the basis of their merit in the written examination under each category separately against the advertised post.

7. Resolution of Tie Cases:

In cases where more than one candidate secure equal aggregate marks in the written Examination, tie will be resolved by applying following methods one after another until the tie is resolved:

- a. Marks in Part-I (i.e. General Intelligence & Reasoning)
- b. Marks in Part-II (i.e. General Awareness)
- c. Marks in Part-III (i.e. Quantitative Aptitude)
- d. Date of birth, with older candidate placed higher.
- e. Alphabetical order in which names of the candidates appear.



8. Action against candidates found guilty of misconduct:

- (a) If candidates are found to indulge at any stage in any of the malpractices during the examination process, their candidature for this examination will be cancelled and they will be debarred from the applying to the Institute.
- (b) The Institute may also report the matter to Police/Investigating Agencies, as deemed fit and the Commission may also take appropriate action to get the matter examined by the concerned authorities/forensic experts, etc.

9. Institute Decision Final:

The decision of the Institute in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s), allotment of examination centres and preparation of merit list debarment for indulging in malpractices will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry/ correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

10. Court's Jurisdiction:

Any dispute in regard to this recruitment will be subject to courts/ having jurisdiction at Pune.
